Dear Friends,

[1] Every move towards Foundation University must be paired with an action to bring every orphan under our care.



[2] For the avoidance of doubt, no single action is taken in the establishment of Foundation University without it being recognized in the plan to bring every single orphan into our benevolent care.



[3] For the would-be enemy among our friends or lurking in our hearts: no orphans, no plan.



[4] It appears the present global system has been working under a necessary assumption that resources are infinite for a reason, namely the non-existence of a select few. Since we now know this, there is no reason not to change that assumption very quickly indeed.

If we find ourselves hesitating then we must ask ourselves why. Concerns about ‘destabilization’ cannot have merit – how can building a business on solid ground, instead of somewhere in the galaxy one but next on some stardust, *not* be beneficial?

The change must occur, perhaps quietly, certainly calmly and *now*.



[5] In addition to spreading darkness, the false assumption that resources are infinite generated false dichotomies in society; for example that following the letter of the law, or working hard to take care of people in need is 'bad', while misinterpreting the law to increase flow of cash, or being able to kick a ball accurately is 'good'.



[6] In addition to spreading darkness, the false assumption that resources are infinite generated false dichotomies with our relationship to the environment; for example, that clean water is 'good' only if it comes in 1 liter plastic bottles, or that energy affordable to individuals is 'bad'.



[7] In addition to spreading darkness, the false assumption that resources are infinite generated false dichotomies within individuals; for example that perceiving oneself as an sexualized or otherwise victimized Object is 'good', but having a strong sense of communal Self is 'bad'.



[8] Armed conflict was necessary for the perpetuation and is responsible for the sustenance of the false assumption that resources are infinite. In reality, armed conflict is never necessary, never inevitable.



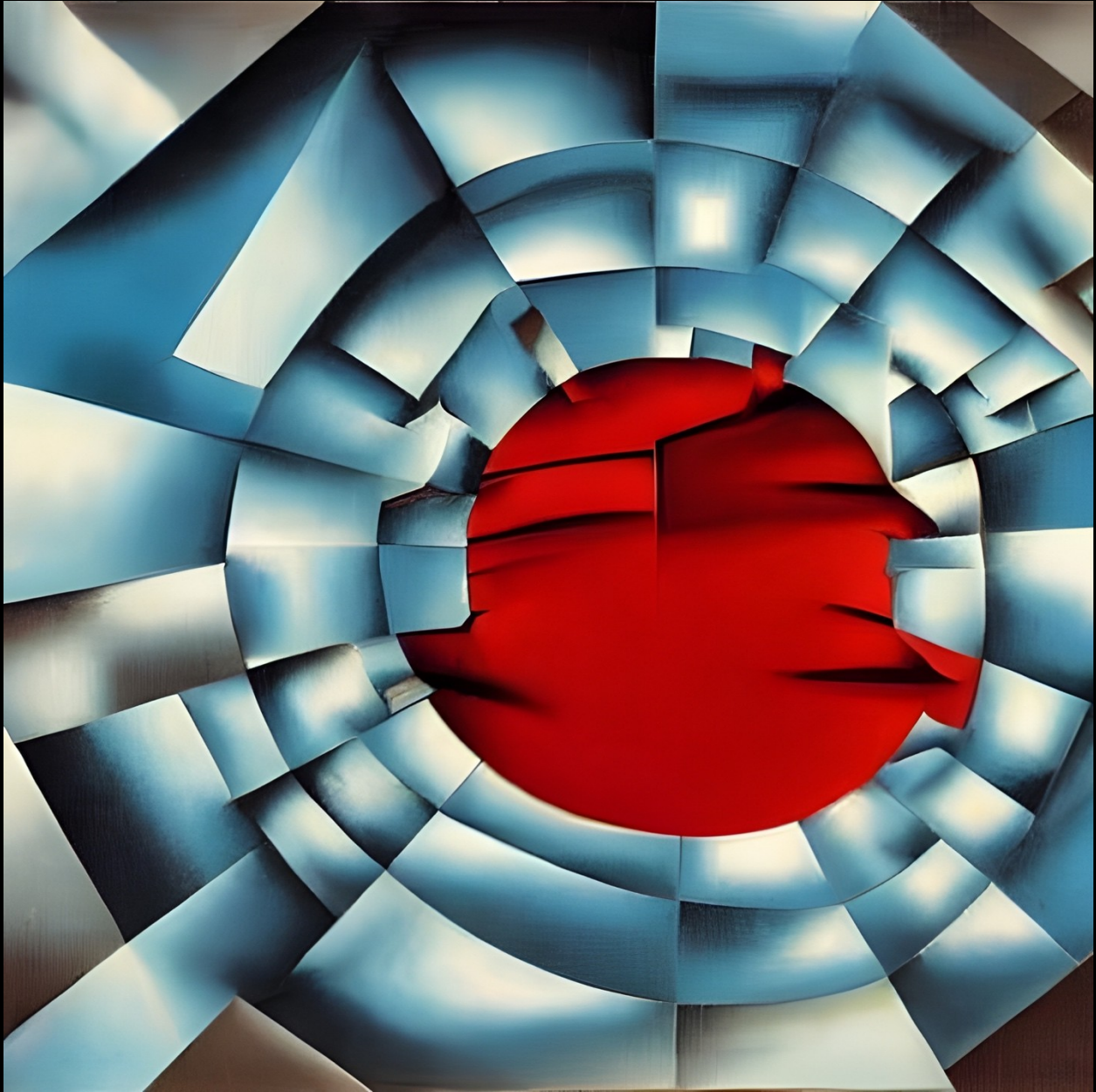
[9] Therefore, continuing to do business under a false assumption that resources are infinite is to feed non-existence or darkness. Removing that assumption is to heal.



[10] To increase the flow of non-existent cash, it was necessary to label Russia as 'very bad'. How quickly, ubiquitously, and thoroughly Russia was labelled 'very bad' is, in reality, absurd. It is also very scary.



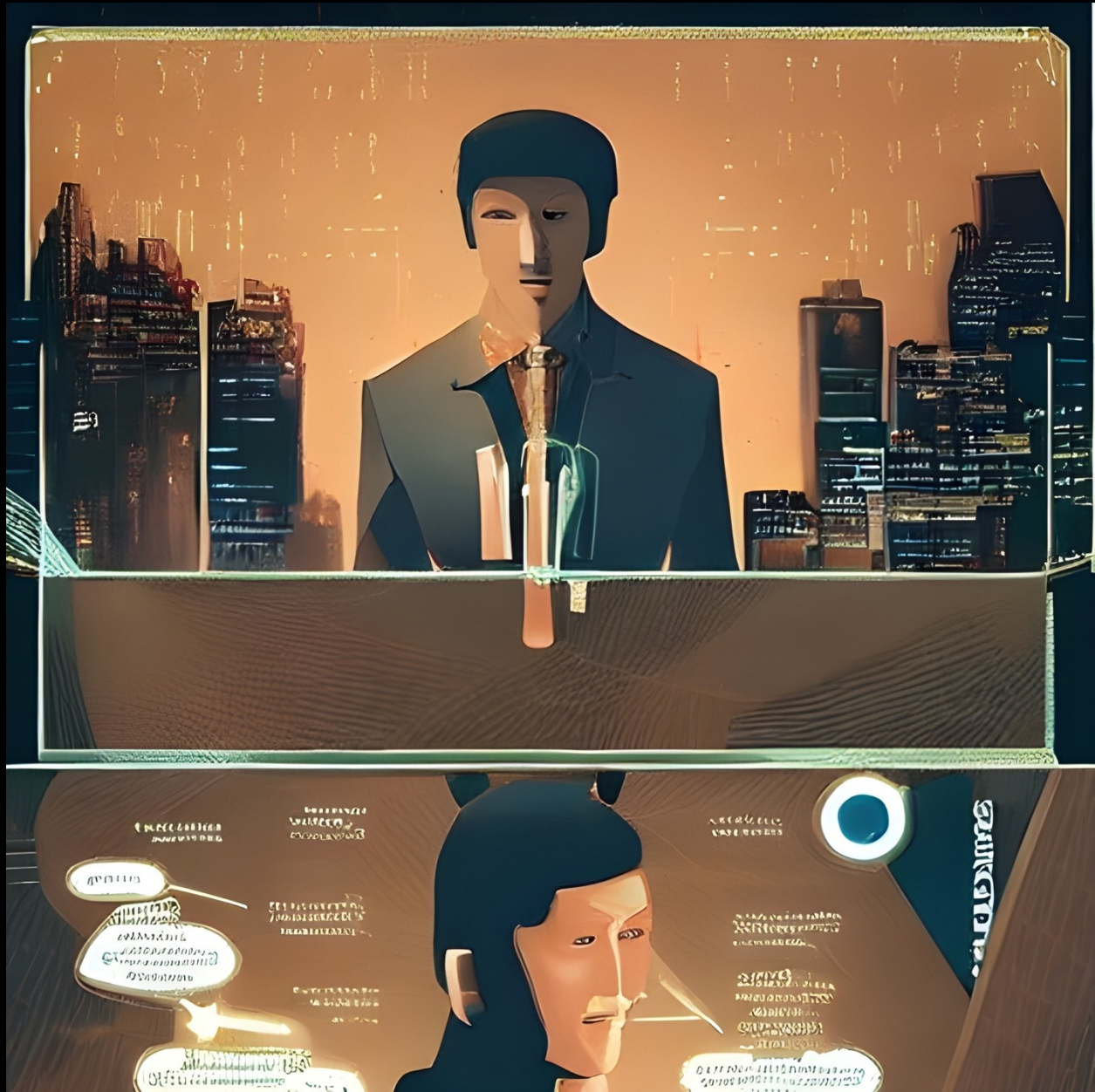
[11] It appears that China is more or less 'good' while business is running, but when she opens her mouth she is 'bad'. She has kept quiet and watched. By keeping quiet, she also played with the assumption that resources are infinite. She may not continue to do so.



[12] China is ready to take us all in her heart, so there is no choice but she enters every heart. It is an old trick, so old we cannot say which way it goes.



[13] The false assumption that resources are infinite was propagated by what we called, for lack of a better term, the demiurge of data. The demiurge of data is a tool to keep us separate and therefore envious, afraid, and selfish.



[14] Language is not simple. Because resources are not infinite, dismantling the demiurge of data requires simplicity and, initially, some anger.



[15] So keep it simple and don't panic. But there will be quiet moments and panic. What if an orphan?



[16] When we find ourselves stalling or fighting amongst ourselves, this is neither simple nor calm. Quietly, calmly, with firmness that comes with a very special kind of anger, we bring ourselves back to question: why are we *not* taking care of this very orphan *now*?
