In Japan, seven cities were chosen for the Foundation University Stations - Tokyo, Yokohama, Osaka, Nagoya, Kyoto, Sapporo, and Hiroshima. In the US, six cities were chosen - Boston, Washington D.C., Chicago, Los Angeles, San Francisco, and Denver. Properties in France, the UK, and Germany were also acquired, though specifics were not stated.



[2] Foundation University was officially launched on Monday 1 May 2023, with government representatives from various ministries, as well as community representatives in attendance at each Station.
